Frequently asked questions (and answers)

Q1. Have all the risks associated with a return to College been considered?

At all stages of this Covid-19 pandemic the College has adhered to Government and NHS England guidance and advice. A comprehensive risk assessment process has taken place and is available upon request from the College Health and Safety Department.

Q2. Are Staff and students being provided with PPE?

At the moment, Government and NHS England advice stated that there is no requirement for teaching staff or students to wear a surgical mask or other PPE whilst at college while maintaining social distancing.

First Aid kits have been upgraded as per Government and NHE guidelines to include masks/aprons and eye protection.

Q3. Will "social distancing" measures be in place at College?

Yes there will. Numerous posters and signage in key areas around the building instructing staff and students to follow Government guidance on social distancing.

Q4. How will "social distancing" be guaranteed?

- Controlled access by Security and Facilities staff to specific areas (Refectory/toilets)
- All classroom have been arranged to maintain 2m spacing.

Q5. Is hand sanitiser available?

Yes. Hand sanitiser is available at the entrance to the building. Alternative hand washing facilities also available for those not wishing to use gels.

Q6. Are toilets and public areas being kept clean?

- Toilet use limited to one person at a time to comply with social distancing protocol.
- The College cleaning staff will be carrying out regular cleaning of all areas being used periodically throughout the day. Bins will be emptied on a regular basis.
- Hand soap dispensers checked on a daily basis, replenished and cleaned down throughout the day by College cleaning staff.
- Information and posters displayed in toilets reminding staff/students of social distancing protocols, importance of washing hands thoroughly and correctly.

Q7. Will equipment be shared during teaching/learning enrichment activities?

- No sharing of equipment. All students will be provided with their own equipment during activities.
- Any equipment used will be cleaned using appropriate cleaning products by staff wearing disposable gloves.
- All disposable materials (paper crafts etc) will be collected and bagged for individual use or disposed of.

Q8. Has food been organised for staff and students?

"Grab bags" have been arranged by Refectory staff which will include sandwiches/drink and fruit.

Q9. What happens during an emergency evacuation?

Security staff will be on site at all times to co-ordinate any emergency evacuation, should the fire alarm sound. A Duty Manager will also be there to provide further support. Social distancing will be enforced at the Assembly point.

Q10. Are First Aiders available should anyone fall ill or have an accident?

Yes, Security staff are trained to administer first aid. First aid kits now include disposable face mask, disposable gown and eye protection.
