1, Tap on the 'Apps' button



2, Tap on the 'Settings' button



3, Scroll the screen down and tap on the 'User & Accounts' button.

6, Enter your email address.



7, Press on the 'Next' button.



8, Enter your Password.



9, Press on the '**Next**' button.

12, The App will try to connect with the mail server, this can take a few minutes, so be patient and do nothing until the next screen, **DO NOT TAP CANCEL**.



13, A dialogue box will be displayed after a few minutes, tap onto the '**OK**' button.



14, On the next screen that appears, select the 'Automatically (Push)' option, and then tap the 'Next' button.



15, Next select how you want to be notified about new emails and calendar events, and then tap onto the '**Next**' button.



16, Next enter a name for the account and then tap on the 'Finish setup' button.



17, Once you have finished setting up Microsoft Exchange from your settings menu, open up your email app



. 19, On the next screen, scroll down the page to the bottom.



20, And tap onto the 'Activate this device admin app'.



21, If the setup has completed successfully, you will see the below dialogue telling you that your emails are syncing with your phone, be aware that this can take a while to complete.



Your phone should now be setup to receive your work emails and your calendar should be populated with your appointments. Tap on the '**Home**' button to return you to the Home screen of your phone.

Set up is now complete.
