In this competition, students are invited to enter one photograph and an accompanying paragraph that explains how the photo interprets the theme/brief. The competition is suitable for students of all abilities who simply enjoy photography as a hobby or wish to go into photography as a career.

BRIEF

Get creative with our 'Human Portraiture' competition.

COMPETITION THEME:

The theme for this year's competition is 'Human Portraiture'.

CREATIVE BRIEF:

We want you to capture a portrait of someone you know. You could use a friend, a family member or even do a self-portrait! Try to portray the persons physical attributes and their emotions. Look at the different types of portraiture that exist as you might decide to do your portrait as painting or sculpture rather than a traditional photo. If you do decide to do a painting or sculpture, please email us a picture of your finished portrait.

The style of photography and equipment you use is entirely up to you, whether it be a mobile phone or digital camera. You could consider a range of experimental techniques utilising backgrounds, lighting and posing. The image must be completely new or something you have recently completed as part of your course at school.

Judges will be looking for lots of creativity and uniqueness of vision.

NOT SURE WHERE TO START?

Why not start by doing some research of your own so that you fully understand the difference between portrait and portraiture and the different types of portraiture as an art form.

GUIDELINES

The Creative and Digital Industries Department (Art and Design) at Kirklees College is inviting budding photographers from all our surrounding schools to take part in the Inter-Schools Photography Competition 2023.

COMPETITION GUIDELINES:

- This competition is open to students in Years 9 to 11. You therefore must be at least 14 years old by 31 August 2022 and not over the age of 16 on 31 August 2023.
- Please ensure you submit x1 photo to meet the 'Human Portraiture' brief.
- Maximum of one image per individual entrant. (You cannot submit more than
 one entry into the competition). All images must be fully created and owned
 by the entrant. Images will not be considered if taken from the internet.
- The image quality needs to be at least 300dpi which is equivalent to a minimum 5 mega pixel camera lens.
- Please make sure you have the permission of anyone who features in your photo.
- Shortlisted images will be picked by the judging panel. The judging panel will be made up of photography and the art and design tutors.
- Deadline for entries is **12pm** on the **21 April 2023.** Shortlisted finalists will be notified by email after the 19 May and invited into college for the final.
- Entries need to be submitted via email to **sturec@kirkleescollege.ac.uk** and accompanied with the entry form otherwise they will not be considered for shortlisting. Please can entries complete all sections of the entry form.
- Judges will select the single winning image they think best suits the brief.
 The judges' decision is final.


