Who are we?

We are a thriving further education (post-16) college. We are uniquely vocational and offer a wide range of 16-18, higher education, adult courses and apprenticeships, supporting thousands of learners each year to gain the skills and qualifications they need to progress into work or to higher levels of study.

Using Indices of Multiple Deprivation, around 65% of the college's intake is from the three bands of highest deprivation and 65% of our students did not obtain at least a grade 4 in English and maths at school. You will be over 18, independent of Kirklees College (not a current student or member of staff) and eligible to act as a charity trustee in England and Wales.
