You will train in our industry standard training kitchens and serve customers in Landings 72, the college's own restaurant, producing modern fast lunches, themed evenings and several special events. Outside of the study areas, there is a well-equipped gym, cash machine and Starbucks coffee shop.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Your timetable will usually be 16 hours a week. If you don't have GCSE Grade 4 in English and maths, then resitting these will be built into your study programme.

You will need to purchase your own safety uniform for working in the kitchens and restaurant. Knives are optional as college will provide these and keep them locked on site. All cooking ingredients are provided and the food is sold in the restaurant and commercial areas, although students can take their dishes home for a small cost.

We have several enrichment activities, competitions and events we involve our students in, these include:

- Michelin star and RAF restaurant takeovers
- Specialist bread workshops
- Combi Guru Competition in Italy

All 16 – 18 students have the opportunity to join our Sports Academy, if your timetable allows. We have a Football Academy and Rugby Academy, which both offer you the chance to train in your chosen field alongside your studies. 
