

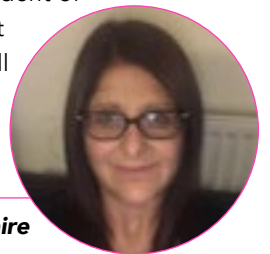

At Kirklees College, we have wonderful Learning Resource Centres where you will be able to access e-books and magazines. The below books will be available to you on through our online catalogue.

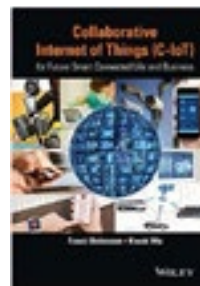
