

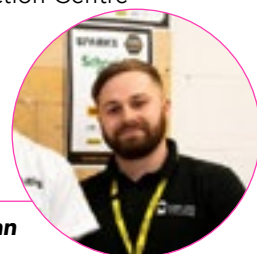

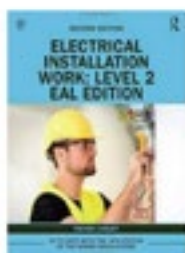
In preparation for you college course, read as many books, magazines and websites and watch as many programmes as possible to learn as much as you can about the industry.

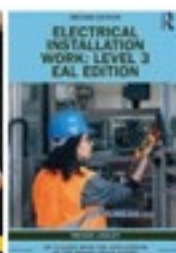
