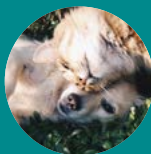

FUNDING AND ELIGIBILITY

The Adult programme is funded through the devolved Adult Education Budget for West Yorkshire. The Mayor of West Yorkshire and the West Yorkshire Combined Authority are investing £65 million a year to improve skills across West Yorkshire – particularly among those who need it most.

Am I eligible for financial support?

You may be entitled to fee remission on eligible courses through the Adult Education Budget. In particular, the following people might be entitled to fully funded access to training:

- Wanting to achieve Level 2 in maths or English for the first time
- Earning less than £21,255 year
- Wanting to achieve basic digital skills
- Wanting to achieve your first full Level 2 or Level 3 (GCSE or A Level equivalent) qualification
