

Funding & Eligibility

The Adult programme is funded through the devolved Adult Skills Fund for West Yorkshire.
The Mayor of West Yorkshire and the West Yorkshire Combined Authority are investing £65 million a year to improve skills across West Yorkshire – particularly among those who need it most.

Am I eligible for financial support?

You may be entitled to fee remission on eligible courses through the Adult Skills Fund.

In particular, the following people may be entitled to fully funded access to training:

- Unemployed and seeking work
- Wanting to achieve Level 2 in maths or English for the first time
- Earning less than £25,000
- Wanting to achieve basic digital skills
- Wanting to achieve your first full Level 2 or Level 3 (GCSE or A-Level equivalent) qualification

If you meet the above criteria and want further information about funding your course, please contact the Course Information team.







Advanced Learner Loans (19+)

An Advanced Learner Loan provides financial help for those studying Level 3 – 6 courses. If you are aged 19 – 23 and already have a Level 3 qualification (e.g. A-Levels) or are aged 24+, you can apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to fund your studies. Costs

When a company takes on an apprentice, there are various costs and funding opportunities depending on whether the company is a levy payer or a non-levy payer.

Every company can utilise their levy and/or Government funding to upskill their existing workforce through Apprenticeships.

Levy Payers

Levy Contribution: Large employers with an annual payroll of over £3 million must pay the apprenticeship levy, which is 0.5% of their total payroll.

Using the Levy: The funds paid into the levy can be used to cover apprenticeship training costs for new apprentices and upskilling your current workforce. You will lose these funds if not used within 24 months.

Cost to Employer: Employers are responsible for paying the apprentice's wages.

Incentives and Grants: Employers receive a £1000 incentive payment for hiring apprentices aged 16-18, or those aged 19-24 who have been in care or have an Education, Health, and Care plan (EHCP). This payment is made around month 6 and then around month 15.

Non-Levy Payers

Co-Investment: Smaller employers who do not pay the levy (those with an annual payroll under £3 million) for apprentices aged 16-21 the government covers 100% of the training costs, for apprentices aged 22+ employers pay only 5% of the training, with the government covering the remaining 95%.

Cost to Employer: Besides the 5% coinvestment for apprentices aged 22+, employers are responsible for paying the apprentice's wages.

Incentives and Grants: Employers receive a £1000 incentive payment for hiring apprentices aged 16-18, or those aged 19-24 who have been in care or have an Education, Health, and Care plan. This payment is made around month 6 and then around 15.

Employers are responsible for paying the apprentice wage – Wage rates as of April 2024.
