

OUR PERFORMANCE

In 2023, Ofsted rated Kirklees College "Good" across all categories – a testament to our collective efforts to raise standards and deliver quality learning experiences.

A significant improvement in overall student achievement rates – from being the lowest for general FE colleges in West Yorkshire – to being the highest for 2023/24.

Financial oversight from the Department for Education has ceased following a period of intervention and the college's continuing financial improvement resulted in a confirmed Financial Health grade of "Outstanding" for 2023/24.

We launched our Digital Innovation Hub in 2023 – a collaborative space where staff explore AI and digital tools through hands-on learning.

In 2025, 90% of our staff completed our annual survey – and 94% said they were proud to work at Kirklees College, up from 80%. This speaks volumes about our shared culture and commitment.

OUR PLACE

In 2023, we opened a new multi-million pounds Animal Centre, giving students hands-on access to industry-standard facilities.

Solar panels were installed across the estate in 2023, advancing our sustainability goals and reducing our carbon footprint.

In 2025, we launched the Groundworks Skills Operator Hub - the first of its kind in the North of England – helping close vital skills gaps in construction and green infrastructures.


